FOR HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION PROGRAMS (Rent, Mortgage and Other Housing Related Expenses)

- The agency/church must fill out an application in full.
- The program must be accessible to all Tri-Cities residents.
- Funds must be distributed/used within 12 months of receipt.
- The agency/church MUST promote and assist selling tickets for our fundraising events.
- You may be required to give a five-minute presentation to our board on what you do and how
 you will use the funds. We will contact you to schedule that appointment if the board feels it is
 necessary.

FOR FOOD PANTRIES

- The agency/church must fill out an application in full.
- Funds will be granted to the agency/church that has the food pantry/served meal site.
- Funds must be distributed/used within 12 months of receipt.
- The agency/church MUST promote and assist in selling tickets for our fundraising events.
